# Cornhole Rules

1. Each team will consist of 2 people.
2. One person from each team at opposite ends of the field.
3. Boards will be 33' from hole to hole.
4. All throws must be underhanded.
5. Player's feet cannot cross the front of the board until the bag leaves the players hand or the throw does not count.
6. Players will alternate throws from one side of the playing field until each player has tossed 4 bags.
7. One point for a bag landing and staying on the board.
8. Three points for a bag going through the hole.
9. Points are scored by each team and added together for all 4 bags.
10. Scoring - The team with the most points scored minus the points from the other team. (Ex. Team 1 scores 5 pts. and Team 2 scores 3 pts. = Team 1 gets 2 pts.)
11. In the event of a tie, the team leading before the tie was created throws first.
12. You must score 21 points or more to win game. You do not have to win by 2.
13. First team to score 21 points or more is the winner and will move on to the next round of play.
14. All rulings by the field judge are **final**.

These are the official rules and regulations of the American Cornhole Organization (ACO). The rules and regulations have been developed and ratified by a majority of ACO members for ACO sanctioned tournament play. The rules are not a mandate, but rather a guideline to promote consistent and standard Cornhole / Corn Toss play around the country. It is the responsibility of each ACO member to strive to meet these rules and regulations in all ACO sanctioned tournaments.
